

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE ATTRIBUTION OF A RESEARCH GRANT (BI), FOR A BACHELOR'S DEGREE HOLDER, UNDER THE PROJECT "WideGAMA - WORLDWIDE GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY MAP", UNIT UIDB/00713/2020, TO BE DEVELOPED IN THE CENTRE FOR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND PUBLIC POLICIES (CAPP) OF THE INSTITUTE FOR SOCIAL AND POLITICAL SCIENCES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF LISBON (ISCSP-ULISBOA)

It is available an application for the attribution of one (1) Research Grant (BI), for a bachelor's degree holder, from February 7th to February 20th of 2023, under the project "*WideGAMA – Worldwide Government Accountability Map*", Unit UIDB/00713/2020, to be developed in the Centre for Public Administration and Public Policies (CAPP) of the Institute for Social and Political Sciences of the University of Lisbon (ISCSP-ULisboa).

Scientific Area:

Public Administration, Political Science, Sociology or Economy.

Admission requirements (cumulative):

- Bachelor's Degree;
- Frequency of a Master's degree in Public Administration, Political Science, Sociology or Economics;
- Proficient in Portuguese and English language, spoken and written.

Working plan:

- Collaboration in the administrative organization and development of CAPP's research project "WideGAMA Worldwide Government Accountability Map";
- Development of support activities to the project management;
- Compilation and organisation of the project's databases (documental collection and empirical data):
- Conducting bibliographic and documentary research;
- Support for the collection and analysis of project data;
- Support for writing and revising scientific texts within the scope of the project;
- Conducting research work and presenting outputs within the scope of the project.

Workplace:

The activities will be developed in CAPP of ISCSP-ULisboa, under the scientific supervision of Professor Ana Lúcia Silva Romão.

Grant duration:

The grant will have the duration of 6 months, expected to start on April 1st of 2023, and may be renewed under the terms foreseen in Regulation of Research Grants of FCT an University of Lisbon. The maximum duration of the contract to be established between ISCSP-ULisboa and the selected applicant is entirely linked to the duration of the project being on its basis, not exceeding its duration.

Monthly Maintenance Allowance:

The amount of the monthly maintenance allowance corresponds to € 875.98, according to the current table of values of grants awarded directly by FCT, I.P. (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores). To the value of the monthly subsidy is added the payment of the charges resulting from the contributions that fall on the first of the steps referred to in article 36 of Decree-Law no 40/89, of February 1st, regarding the Voluntary Social Insurance, whose adhesion is the responsibility of the fellow.

Selection Methods:

Applicants will be ranked on a scale from 0 to 100 points.

The selection of candidates will be based on the Curricular Evaluation (50%) and the Interview (50%).

- 1. The <u>curricular evaluation</u> will be weighed as follows:
 - a) Knowledge in quantitative data analysis, preferentially with domain in the use of specific software, namely SPSS (17,5%);
 - b) Area of knowledge and grade obtained in the bachelor's degree (17,5%);
 - c) Knowledge of research methodology and scientific writing rules (7,5%);
 - d) Previous participation and integration experience in research project teams (7,5%).



- 2. The interview will be weighed as follows:
 - a) Predisposition to carry out research work (12,5%);
 - b) Proficiency in Portuguese and English language, advanced level (12,5%);
 - c) Demonstrated affinity with the topic of Accountability (10%);
 - d) Motivation for obtaining the research grant (7,5%);
 - e) Communication and interpersonal relationship skills (5%);
 - f) Knowledge of other foreign languages, specifically Spanish, Italian or German (2,5%).

No candidate should be privileged, benefited, impaired, or deprived of any right or exempted of any duty on the basis of, namely, ancestry, age, gender image or identity, sexual orientation, marital status, family situation, economic situation, education, origin or social condition, genetic heritage, reduced working capacity, disability, chronic disease, nationality, ethnic origin or race, place of origin, religion, political or ideological convictions and union trade membership.

Notification Process of Results:

The final results of the evaluation will be publicized on an alphabetically ordered list, posted in a visible and public place of ISCSP-ULisboa. The approved candidate will be notified by email.

Application date:

The application is available from February 7th to February 20th of 2023.

Application presentation:

The applications must be formalized, mandatorily, accompanied by the following documents:

- a) Application letter with the identification of the candidate and procedure to which it relates;
- b) Documents proving that the candidate meets the admission requirements, namely a copy of the qualification certificate of the Bachelor's degree, with final average obtained;
- c) Detailed Curriculum Vitae;
- d) Document proving enrolment in the master's degree;
- e) Declaration under oath that there is no professional or service provision activity that violates the duty of exclusive dedication;
- f) Copy of the civil identification document and, whenever applicable, copy of the proof of residence permit or other legally equivalent document;
- g) Motivation letter;
- h) Documents supporting the training obtained in the areas of curricular evaluation;
- i) Other supporting documents considered relevant for the application process.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution, in accordance with Decree-Law n.º 66/2018, of August 16th, and Ordinance n.º 33/2019, of January 25th.
