

**FOR THE RESEARCH PROJECT “CRISEA -COMPETING REGIONAL
INTEGRATIONS IN SOUTHEAST ASIA” (ID 770562)**

The period for the submission of applications to one (1) Research Grant (BI) will open from 22 to 26 October, 2018, for the research project CRISEA – Competing Regional Integrations in Southeast Asia” (ID770562), in development at the Centre for Public Administration and Public Policies (CAPP), in collaboration with the Orient Institute (IO), Instituto Superior de Ciências Sociais e Políticas (ISCSP), University of Lisbon (UL), supported by EU funds from H2020.

Scientific Area

International Relations

Admission Requirements:

Applicants must prove they have all of the following requirements:

- Master’s degree in International Relations;
- Experience in qualitative research in international contexts, specifically Asian and European.

Work Plan:

Research work in a project that includes 13 international institutions. Collaboration with the portuguese research team on the analysis of data gathered in field work in Southeast Asia (Indonesia, Thailand and Malaysia).

Work place:

The research activities will be carried out at the Centre for Public Administration and Public Policies (CAPP), at Instituto Superior de Ciências Sociais e Políticas (ISCSP), under the supervision of Professor Andrea Valente and Professor Nuno Canas Mendes.

Duration of the Fellowship:

The fellowship will have a 4 month duration, starting on the 1st December, 2018, and will be eventually renewable up to the maximum allowed period provided in article 7 of the Fellowships and Grants Regulations of Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P. - 2018.

Monthly allowance:

The monthly allowance is €980, according to the current table of fellowship allowances directly attributed by FCT, I.P. in the country (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores). To the value of monthly allowance will be added payment of charges resulting from contributions to the first level of the Voluntary Social Insurance Scheme, as referred in article 36º of Decreto – Lei nº 40/89, of February 1st, whose adherence is of the exclusive responsibility of the Research fellow.

Selection Methods:

The selection methods will include a curricular evaluation (50%) and an interview (50%).

I. The curricular evaluation will be weighted as follows:

1. High merit academic curriculum (25%)
2. Previous experience in qualitative research in Asian and European contexts (25%)

II. Interview (50%);

No candidate shall be privileged, benefited, prejudiced, excluded or impaired from any right, or exempted from any duty on the basis of ascendancy, age, sex, gender, sexual orientation, civil state, family situation, economic situation, education, origin or social condition, genetic heritage, reduced capacity for work, disability, chronic disease, nationality, ethnic origin or race, place of origin, language, religion, political or ideological convictions or union membership.

Process of notification:

The final results of the selection process will be published in a alphabetically ordered list, posted in a visible and public place at ISCSP, and the selected candidates will be notified by e-mail.

Application deadline:

The application period is open from 22 to 26 October, 2018.

Application process:

Applications must be mandatorily formalized with an application letter with the identification of the procedure, sent with the following attached documents:

- a) Detailed Curriculum;
- b) Certificate of qualifications;
- c) Documents proving the fulfillment of the admission requirements;
- d) Documents proving previous experience in qualitative research done in Asian and European contexts;
- e) Other documents considered relevant.
