

It is available an application for the attribution of 1 (one) Research Grant (BI), for a bachelor's degree holder, from February 16 to March 1, 2022, under the project "EQUAL: Equality before the law and the right to self-determination of persons with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities in Portugal: An exploratory study", developed in the Interdisciplinary Center for Gender Studies (CIEG) of the Institute for Social and Political Sciences (ISCSP) of the University of Lisbon (ULisboa).

Scientific Area:

Sociology or Social Policy

Admission requirements (cumulative)

- Degree in Sociology or Political Sciences
- Frequency of a masters in Sociology of Social Policy
- Proven knowledge of written and spoken English.

Working plan:

- Collection and systematization of updated bibliography;
- Contacts with partner institutions and other agents involved in the execution of the project;
- Construction of methodological instruments;
 - Organization, promotion and support for conducting interviews, case studies, work sessions and focus groups;
- Promotion of social networks and content creation;
- Treatment and analysis of the collected information;
- Presentation of communications at scientific events;
- Construction of pedagogical and scientific dissemination materials;
- Preparation of reports and expected outputs.

Legislation and regulations:

Research Fellowship Statute, approved by Law n.º 40/2004, of 18 August, in its current wording, amended by Decree-Law n.º 123/2019, of 28 August.

Workplace:

The activities will be developed in CIEG/ ISCSP-ULisboa, under the scientific supervision of Professor Paula Campos Pinto.

Grant duration:

The grant will have the duration of 12 months, starting on March 21, 2022. The maximum duration of the contract to be established between ISCSP-ULisboa and the selected applicant is entirely linked to the duration of the project being on its basis, not exceeding its duration.

Monthly Maintenance Allowance:

The amount of the monthly maintenance allowance corresponds to € 835.98, according to the current table of values of grants awarded directly by FCT, I.P. (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores). To the value of the monthly subsidy is added the payment of the charges resulting from the contributions that fall on the first of the steps referred to in article 36 of Decree-Law n.º 40/89, of February 1st, regarding the Voluntary Social Insurance, whose adhesion is the responsibility of the fellow.

Selection Methods:

The selection of candidates will be based on the curricular evaluation (50%) and the interview (50%).

1. The curricular evaluation (50%) will be weighed as follows:
 - a) Final grade of the degree (25%);
 - b) Proven knowledge of the English language (25%).

2. Interview (50%)
 - a) Suitability of the candidate's profile (25%);
 - b) Interest and knowledge about the area of the project's development (25%).

No candidate should be privileged, benefited, impaired, or deprived of any right or exempted of any duty on the basis of, namely, ancestry, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender image or identity, marital status, family situation, economic situation, education, origin or social condition, genetic heritage, reduced working capacity, disability, chronic disease, nationality, ethnic origin or race, place of origin, language, religion, political or ideological convictions and union trade membership.

Notification Process:

The final results of the evaluation will be publicized on an alphabetically ordered list, posted in a visible and public place of ISCSP. The approved candidate will be notified by email.

Application date:

The application is available from February 16 to March 1, 2022.

Application presentation:

The applications must be formalized, **mandatorily**, by sending a letter of application with the identification of the procedure to which it relates, accompanied by the following documents:

- a) *Curriculum Vitae*;
- b) Certificate of qualifications;
- c) Declaration of enrolment in the master's programme;
- d) Documents certifying that the admission requirements are fulfilled;
- e) Other supporting documents considered relevant towards the application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution, in accordance with Decree-Law n.º 66/2018, of 16 August, and Ordinance n.º 33/2019, of 25 January.
