PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE ATTRIBUTION OF ONE RESEARCH GRANT (BI) FOR A MASTER'S DEGREE HOLDER, UNDER THE PROJECT "EDE – EUROPEAN DISABILITY EXPERTISE", FUNDED BY THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION, TO BE HELD AT THE INTERDISCIPLINARY CENTRE FOR GENDER STUDIES (CIEG) OF THE INSTITUTE FOR SOCIAL AND POLITICAL SCIENCES (ISCSP) OF THE UNIVERSITY OF LISBON (ULISBOA)

It is available an application for the attribution of 1 (one) Research Grant (BI), for a Master's degree holder, from August 12th to August 26th, under the project "EDE – EUROPEAN DISABILITY EXPERTISE", to be held at the Interdisciplinary Center for Gender Studies (CIEG) of the Institute for Social and Political Sciences (ISCSP) of the University of Lisbon (ULisboa), and funded by the European Commission.

Scientific Area:

Social Sciences

Admission requirements:

- Master's degree in Social Sciences;
- Frequency of a PhD program in Political Sciences;
- Proven research experience in the field of disability.

Work plan:

- Support the collection and analysis of information for the production of thematic reports on issues related to people with disabilities;
- Support the preparation of scientific reports and articles, in Portuguese and English;
- Support content reviewing and management of DOTCOM database;
- Support in managing research processes and disseminating scientific knowledge in the field of disability.

Workplace:

The activities will be developed in CIEG, Institute for Social and Political Sciences, under the scientific supervision of Professor Paula Campos Pinto.

Grant duration:

The grant will last until 13th March 2025, expected to start on October 1st, and may be renewed under the terms foreseen in the Regulation of Research Grants of FCT and the University of Lisbon. The maximum duration of the contract to be established between ISCSP-ULisboa and the selected applicant is entirely linked to the duration of the project being on its basis, not exceeding its duration.

Monthly Maintenance Allowance:

The amount of the monthly maintenance allowance corresponds to €1.259,64, according to the current table of values of grants awarded directly by FCT, I.P. (<https://www.fct.pt/fct-atualizou-o-valor-das-bolsas-de-investigacao-3/>). To the value of the monthly subsidy is added the payment of the charges resulting from the contributions that fall on the first of the steps referred to in article 36 of Decree-Law n.º 40/89, of February 1st, regarding the Voluntary Social Insurance, whose adhesion is the responsibility of the fellow.

Selection Methods:

Candidates will be ranked on a scale from 0 to 100 values.

The selection methods will be based on the curricular evaluation (60%) and the interview (40%).

The curricular evaluation (60%) will be weighed as follows:

- a) Proven experience in research projects in the field of disability (30%);
- b) Proven knowledge of English language (15%);
- c) Proven experience in teamwork (15%);

The interview (40%) will be weighed as follows:

- a) Suitability of the candidate's profile (15%);
- b) Knowledge of the project's field (15%);
- c) Motivation for working on the research project (10%).

No candidate should be privileged, benefited, impaired, or deprived of any right or exempted of any duty on the basis of, namely, ancestry, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender image or identity, marital status, family situation, economic situation, education, origin or social condition, genetic heritage, reduced working capacity, disability, chronic disease, nationality, ethnic origin or race, place of origin, language, religion, political or ideological convictions, and union trade membership.

Notification Process:

The final evaluation results will be publicized on an alphabetically ordered list, and posted in a visible and public place of ISCSP-ULisboa. The approved candidate will be notified by email.

Application date:

The application is available from August 12th to August 26th of 2024.

Application presentation:

The applications must be formalized, **mandatorily**, accompanied by the following documents:

- a) Application letter with the identification of the candidate and the procedure to which it relates;
- b) *Curriculum Vitae*;
- c) Documents certifying that the admission requirements are fulfilled, namely a copy of the qualification certificate of the Master's degree, with final average obtained;
- d) Document proving enrolment in the PhD in Political Sciences;
- e) Motivation Letter;
- f) Copy of the civil identification document and, whenever applicable, copy of the proof of residence permit or other legally equivalent document;
- g) Documents proving compliance with admission requirements;
- h) Other supporting documents considered relevant for the application process.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution, in accordance with Decree-Law n.º 66/2018, of 16 August, and Ordinance n.º 33/2019, of 25 January. Failure to submit the documents referred to in paragraphs a) to h) automatically determines the non-admission to the procedure.
