Public notice for the attribution of a Scientific Initiation Grant (BIC), under the project “Study on the perceptions of disability and the rights of people with disabilities”, to be developed in the Disability and Human Rights Observatory (ODDH) of the Institute for Social and Political Sciences of the University of Lisbon (ISCSP-ULisboa)

It is available an application for the attribution of one (1) Scientific Initiation Grant (BIC), from August 18th to August 29th of 2025, under the project “Study on the perceptions of disability and the rights of people with disabilities”, to be developed in the Disability and Human Rights Observatory (ODDH) of the Institute for Social and Political Sciences of the University of Lisbon (ISCSP-ULisboa).

Scientific Area:

International Relations.

Admission requirements:

- Frequency of Bachelor's degree in International Relations;
- Proven research experience in the area of disability;
- Knowledge of SPSS and Excel.

Working plan:

- Support in statistical analysis of data using SPSS and Excel;
- Support the preparation of reports and other scientific dissemination publications related to the research project/ODDH;
- Support the production of the newsletter, email management, and updating the ODDH website concerning the research project;
- Support the organization of scientific dissemination events related to the project/ODDH.

Workplace:

The activities will be developed in ODDH of ISCSP-ULisboa, under the scientific supervision of Professor Maria Paula Pestana de Freitas da Silva Faria Campos Pinto.

Grant duration:

The grant will last for an estimated 3 and a half months, expected to start on September 15th of 2025, and may be renewed under the terms foreseen in Regulation of Research Grants of FCT an University of Lisbon. The maximum duration of the contract to be established between ISCSP-ULisboa and the selected applicant is entirely linked to the duration of the project being on its basis, not exceeding its duration.

Monthly Maintenance Allowance:

The amount of the monthly maintenance allowance corresponds to € 651.12, according to the current table of values of grants awarded directly by FCT, I.P. (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores). To the value of the monthly subsidy is added the payment of the charges resulting from the contributions that fall on the first of the steps referred to in article 36 of Decree-Law nº 40/89, of February 1st, regarding the Voluntary Social Insurance, whose adhesion is the responsibility of the fellow.

Selection Methods:

Applicants will be ranked on a scale from 0 to 100 values.

The selection of candidates will be based on the Curricular Evaluation (50%) and the Interview (50%).

1. The curricular evaluation will be weighed as follows:
 - a) Research experience in the field of Disability (25%);
 - b) Experience in data analysis activities using SPSS (25%).
2. The interview will be weighed as follows:
 - a) Adequacy of the candidate's profile (10%);
 - b) Interest in the field of disability and human rights (20%)
 - c) Motivation and experience to participate in organization activities and execute research projects (20%).

No candidate should be privileged, benefited, impaired, or deprived of any right or exempted of any duty on the basis of, namely, ancestry, age, gender image or identity, sexual orientation, marital status, family situation, economic situation, education, origin or social condition, genetic heritage, reduced working capacity, disability, chronic disease, nationality, ethnic origin or race, place of origin, religion, political or ideological convictions and union trade membership.

Notification Process of Results:

The final results of the evaluation will be publicized on an alphabetically ordered list, posted in a visible and public place of ISCSP-ULisboa. The approved candidate will be notified by email.

Application date:

The application is available from August 18th to August 29th of 2025.

Application presentation:

The applications must be formalized, mandatorily, accompanied by the following documents:

- a) Application letter with the identification of the candidate and procedure to which it relates;
- b) Documents proving that the candidate meets the admission requirements, namely a copy of proof enrolment in Bachelor's degree in International Relations;
- c) Detailed *Curriculum Vitae*;
- d) Declaration under oath that there is no professional or service provision activity that violates the duty of exclusive dedication;
- e) Copy of the civil identification document and, whenever applicable, copy of the proof of residence permit or other legally equivalent document;
- f) Motivation letter;
- g) Documents proving compliance with admission requirements;
- h) Other supporting documents considered relevant for the application process.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution, in accordance with Decree-Law n.º 66/2018, of August 16th, and Ordinance n.º 33/2019, of January 25th.
